
Important Tips

Aquarium Maintenance



- Keep the water clean. Use simple filters.
- · Operate air pumps continually.
- · Use only flake/ pellet forms of feed.
- · Keep separate hand nets for each tank.
- Stock limited number of fishes in the tank (4 – 5 cm Length / Lt).
- Quarantine the fish before putting into the aquarium.





- Deploy suitable filteration systems U.V., Mechanical or Biofilter.
- · Maintain water quality in optimum range: Salinity (30 - 35 ppt); pH (7.8 - 8.2); Ammonia (<0.1 ppm); Dissolved Oxygen (>3 ppm).







Fish Health Management

- Examine fish for discoloration, lesion and wound.
- Check eyes for 'cloudiness' indication of infection.
- Note abnormal behavior whirling and erratic swimming.
- Follow standard quarantine and treatment protocols.
