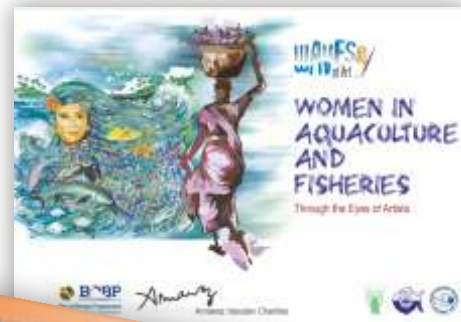
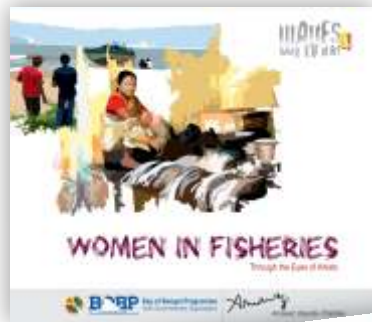
BOBP-IGO has organized several international conferences, panel discussions, and other events, and has published reports to enhance its impact
